

## Tech Rider – Sitar Fusion



### Arrival Time and Set Up

- The artists will arrive approximately one hour prior to show time to set up.
- The use of a stage is preferred. If no stage, a small riser should be set up if possible.
- The performance space should be 10' x 20' and should be cleared and cleaned prior to arrival.
- The performance will be 40 minutes followed by a 10-minute Q&A.
- Tear down will take roughly 20 minutes

I would like to introduce Sitar Fusion: Anwar Khurshid originally from Pakistan and Geneviève Beaulieu from Québec. Through their music and dance, they will tell the story of Ibn Battuta who traveled to many countries over 700 years ago. Today, we are going to visit some of these countries through music and dance. During the presentation, there will be a dancer who shows how words are expressed in dance. You will have a chance to ask questions at the end.

### Facilities and Equipment

- 2 music stands
- 2 chairs
- 3 mics
- 3 mic stands – one with a boom
- 2 speakers
- One mixing board
- 3 XLR cable with phantom power (20 or 50 feet)
