Amount of Performers: 4

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Advise performers of staff washroom location
- Provide access to a regular power outlet and a power extension if available
- Inform the performers of scheduling requirements (i.e. recess, lunch, end of day times, etc.)
- Inform the performers if photo or video will be taken during the show

Note: KUNE will need the following items:

- 4 chairs
- 4 vocal microphones (w/mic cables and mic stands) and PA system: Kune is able to provide enough
 microphones for all but if the school has any microphones or PA system, please make it available to
 the performers.

Set Up Checklist

Distribute study guides to colleagues
Reserve performance space for total time (listed above)
Ensure load-in is accessible directly from artist vehicle to performance space
Reserve parking for 3 vehicles
Arrange for bells, announcements, PA systems to be turned off during performance
Ensure space is cleaned and cleared prior to artist(s) arrival
Greet artist(s) at arrival time
Arrange for students to be seated by the performance start time
Arrange for teachers to attend and supervise students throughout the show

Introduction (optional): Created through the Royal Conservatory of Music as a celebration of Canada's cultural diversity and pluralism, Kuné showcases their traditional knowledge of music from Latin America, Africa and the African Diaspora, the Middle East, Asia and North America.
